

NOTICE FOR BIDS

CITY OF WINTER GARDEN

9TH STREET GRAVITY SEWER, FORCE MAIN AND WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT NO. 16-020

The City of Winter Garden, Florida, is accepting sealed bids at 300 West Plant Street, Winter Garden, Florida 34787; until **July 11, 2018, at 2:00 p.m.**, at which time all bids will be opened and publicly read aloud.

The project is for construction of new gravity sewers, force mains and water mains on 9th Street and adjacent roads. The project includes furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, restoration, and incidentals to construct the new mains by both open trench, jack and bore, and directional drill construction methods and connecting to existing mains and services. Removal and abandonment of existing mains is also included, as well as, bypass operations, maintenance of traffic (MOT), temporary erosion and sediment control and full restoration activities to include, but not limited to, asphalt pavement, sidewalks, curbing, landscaping, malboxes, fences, and signage. MBE/DBE/WBE participation is encouraged.

Each bidder will be required to purchase a bid package from Tetra Tech and be a Registered Plan Holder prior to submitting his/her/its bid and have a representative attend a **MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING**. The Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting is scheduled for **2:00 p.m. on June 12, 2018**, at the Winter Garden City Hall, 300 West Plant Street, Winter Garden, Florida, 34787. Bidders who have not purchased bid packages from Tetra Tech prior to submitting their bids and do not have a representative attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting shall be disqualified.
