### CANVASS THE RESULTS OF THE MARCH 13, 2001 ELECTION

City Clerk Montoya presented the following Absentee Ballots:

27 Approved

5 To be checked

4 Not returned

This matches the total Absentee Ballots requested of 36. After reviewing the unopened 32 Absentee Ballots, the Canvassing Board accepted 30. All Absentee Ballots were verified through the Orange County Supervisor of Elections Office prior to this meeting. The City Clerk presented the Certificate of Results from the polling place.
