CANVASSING BOARD MEETING MINUTES March 10, 2015

A meeting of the City of Winter Garden Canvassing Board was called to order by City Clerk Golden at the Orange County Supervisor of Elections office, 119 W. Kaley Street, Orlando, Florida, on Tuesday, March 10, 2015 at 4:10 p.m.

MEMBERS PRESENT: City Clerk Kathy Golden, Andy Bruns, and Lee Douglas
OTHERS PRESENT: Assistant City Clerk Angee Grimmage (Recording Clerk)

I. Call to order and review of legal ad

The meeting was called to order by Canvassing Board Member Golden.

Count Confirmation of Absentee Ballots Received

The Canvassing Board began the accounting of absentee ballots. The number of absentee ballots delivered and confirmed at this time was 134.

The meeting was duly advertised and the Canvassing Board reviewed the legal ad.

II. Public Comment – There was none.

III. Approval of meeting minutes - February 11, 2015 and February 24, 2015

Motion by Canvassing Board Member Douglas to approve meeting minutes of February 11, 2015 and February 24, 2015 as submitted. Seconded by Canvassing Board Member Bruns and carried unanimously 3-0.

IV. Review logic and accuracy test results on voting equipment performed February 26, 2015

The Canvassing Board reviewed the Logic and Accuracy test performed by the Orange County Supervisor of Elections on February 26, 2015 as noted in their agenda package.

V. Perform pre-tabulating logic and accuracy test on absentee voting equipment

The Canvassing Board observed the Logic and Accuracy test performed by an Orange County Supervisor of Elections staff member who explained that the law requires that a series of test ballots be run on the tabulating equipment. The Canvassing Board witnessed and certified to the accuracy of the test results.

VI. Canvass absentee/provisional ballots

The Canvassing Board discussed an absentee ballot where the person signed the wrong ballot. The Canvassing Board reviewed the adopted Canvassing Board Criteria 2015 matrix for what is to be done in those cases.

The Canvassing board was told of an additional ballot that had arrived and directed Orange County Supervisor of Elections staff to process it.

The Canvassing Board **recessed** its meeting at 5:02 p.m. and **reconvened** at 7:06 p.m.

The Canvassing Board discussed an absentee ballot that was identified as a non-signature match on the ballot envelope. There were two persons in the same household and one had not voted. The Orange County Supervisor of Elections explained that their Canvassing Board would have accepted this ballot, giving credit to the signer and correcting their system.

Motion by Canvassing Board Member Douglas to ACCEPT the absentee envelope labeled for Ranee Vejmaneesri as the ballot cast by Robert Joseph Smith. Seconded by Canvassing Board Member Brunns and carried unanimously 3-0.

An Orange County Supervisor of Elections staff member explained that the provisional ballot cast at the precinct is for a voter who is not registered. There was discussion that the county and a statewide database were searched and nothing was found for this voter. Canvassing Board Member Douglas noted that the criteria states that if the voter name is not found and/or is not registered to vote, then it would be rejected.

Motion by Canvassing Board Member Douglas to REJECT the provisional ballot for Di Thach as there is no voter registration on file, County or Statewide. Seconded by Canvassing Board Member Brunns and carried unanimously 3-0.

The Canvassing Board **recessed** its meeting at 7:26 p.m. and **reconvened** at 7:33 p.m.

The Canvassing Board was given printed results for Precinct 4103. Canvassing Board Member Golden read election results.

The Canvassing Board confirmed that the total number of votes counted is 360.

Canvassing Board Member Golden noted that there were no more ballots to be counted for the District 4 election. David Kassander received 107 votes and Colin Sharman received 253 votes.

Motion by Canvassing Board Member Douglas to accept the results. Seconded by Canvassing Board Member Bruns and carried unanimously 3-0.

VII. Post-tabulating logic and accuracy test on absentee voting equipment was performed.

VIII. Possible certification of the election results and audit
