



Litter & Trash

Litter and trash are common stormwater pollutants. In addition to degrading water quality as the material degrades or spreads, litter can clog or block stormwater inlets and pipes, which can lead to flooding. Trash also harms aquatic life and wetland species such as frogs, fish, and birds either through ingestion or water quality degradation and food and light reduction.

Place trash and recycling containers out only on your collection day(s) and keep them covered at all times. If your recycling container does not have a lid, place the heavier materials on top to weigh down the other material.
