Did you know?

More quick tips to ensure that your garbage, recycling and yard waste is collected each week:

1. **Place containers on the curb—not in the street.** This will prevent street traffic and promote accessibility for collection trucks.
2. **Avoid placing containers in front of the mail box.** Doing so may block access and cause interruption in mail delivery.
3. **Place containers on the curb no later than 7 am on collection day.** There is no set schedule for individual pick-up routes so pick-up times may vary, depending on weather, traffic conditions and the amount of material collected throughout the route.
4. **Remove containers from the curb no later than 7 pm on collection day.** This promotes a safe neighborhood for the evening hours.


